DESCRIPTION (field, expectations, comments):

The candidates have to conform to the conditions stated in art. 109 of Higher Education Law dated 27.07.2005. (uniform text: Journal of Laws of the Republic of Poland 2016, item 1842 with further amendments).

The requirements:

A candidate must demonstrate a commitment to the experimental research within the possibilities of the Institute of Experimental Physics, Faculty of Physics of the University of Warsaw, or interdisciplinary research closely related to the experimental physics. He/she should have high quality skills as well as practical experience in experimental research (documented by publications) and qualifications to effectively communicate with collaborators within research groups. The candidate is also expected to be active in gaining externally funded research grants, and to carry out the research work in collaboration with good external laboratories if the research profile requires this.

The candidate should have PhD in physics, chemistry or related fields.

Successful candidate must demonstrate a commitment to teaching excellence in both introductory and advanced courses in his discipline. The teaching duties are at the level of 210 hours per academic year. The candidate is expected to continuously increase the quality of teaching and to relate teaching with recent scientific achievements.

The successful candidate will be employed full-time for the period of 2 years, starting from October 1st, 2018.

Interested candidates should submit to the address ifd@fuw.edu.pl scanned copies of the following documents (as PDF files with file names including first name and surname of the candidate as well as the description of the position – ASYSTENT):

1. Application for the position required accompanied by the statement of acceptance for the treatment of personal data: “I hereby give consent for my personal data to be processed for the purposes of recruitment, in accordance with the Personal Data

Protection Act dated 29.08.1997 (uniform text: Journal of Laws of the Republic of Poland 2016, item 922)”;

2. CV;
3. Information about candidate’s scientific career and teaching experience;
4. A proposed research plan;
5. List of scientific publications with a short description of the most important achievement in the candidate’s opinion;
6. Copy of PhD diploma

In addition, at least 2 opinions from professors or senior research staff members familiar with the scientific activity of the candidate are required. The opinions are confidential and have to be e-mailed directly to the address ifd@fuw.edu.pl (and not transmitted by the candidate).

Note: The successful candidate will be required to supplement some of the above scanned copies by the original documents according to procedures being in operation at the University of Warsaw.

The candidate might be asked for an interview with the commission appointed by the Dean of the Faculty, preferably in a form of teleconference. The entire procedure will be concluded before September 10th, 2018. The decision of the commission will be announced to the candidates individually by e-mail.

This recruitment is the first step in the procedure of employing an academic teacher and its positive result will be a base for further proceedings.
