

**Competition for a scholarship for a doctoral student
as part of the NCN OPUS 19 project**

Project title: "Strongly interacting and tightly confined quantum systems: a new quantum technology toolbox"

The scholarship is awarded in accordance with the rules contained in the Regulations on granting scientific scholarships in research projects financed by the National Science Center, introduced by the resolution of the Council of the National Science Center No. 25/2019 on March 14, 2019.

Description of tasks:

The research work will be carried out at the Institute of Theoretical Physics at the Faculty of Physics of the University of Warsaw, as part of the NCN OPUS 19 project "Strongly interacting and tightly confined quantum systems: a new quantum technology toolbox"

The student will conduct theoretical research on the topic of ultracold polar molecules, developing effective numerical methods of describing their interactions and collisions.

The amount of the scholarship in the project is PLN 5,000 (the amount may include public and legal charges in accordance with applicable regulations). The selected candidate will be recruited to the Doctoral School of the University of Warsaw. Depending on the admission procedure, the salary may be increased.

Requirements:

1. The candidate should have the status of a doctoral student at the moment of commencing the implementation of tasks in the project.
2. Very good knowledge of quantum mechanics, optics and solid state physics.
3. Fluent English.
4. High motivation for scientific work and international cooperation.

The application should include:

- a cover letter with information on the processing of personal data - information and consent clauses (available on the website <http://bsp.adm.uw.edu.pl/bsp/druki-i-formularze/>), in PDF format with a scanned signature;
- curriculum vitae containing information about the current research activity, achievements and awards as well as scientific interests
- list of publications and conference presentations
- copies of obtained academic diplomas

Selected candidates will be notified individually about the date of a possible interview. The competition will be resolved by June 15, 2021.

Purpose and legal grounds of data processing

Data retention period

Your personal data collected in this recruitment process shall be stored over the period of three months from the date the recruitment process is completed.

In case you agree to process your data in future recruitments, your data shall be used over the period of nine months.

Data recipients

Officers authorized by the Controller shall have access to your personal data, the processing of which is in the scope of their duties.

Data transfer outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

Your personal data shall be disclosed to subjects authorized by law. Signing-in is through Google Forms. Your personal data may be also processed by our provider of G-Suit for education by Google Company in their data processing centres.⁷ Your data shall be protected under the standards of the Privacy Shield, accepted by the European Commission.⁸ This shall guarantee an adequate level of data security.
