We seek a candidate for university professor position to join the Institute of Geophysics, Faculty of Physics, University of Warsaw.

that We expect the candidate will document his competencies of in the area nanooptics/plasmonicss/metamaterials and propose an innovative research program coherent with profiles of at least one of research groups at the Information Optics Departament. Duties of the successful candidate will include 180 hours (per academic year) of teaching at the Faculty of Physics, University of Warsaw.

Scientific, teaching and organizational activities of the employee will be a subject of regular periodic evaluation.

This is a tenure position.

The contract shall begin on Feb 1<sup>st</sup> 2025 or Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 2025.

Necessary requirements are:

- 1. habilitation in science (or equivalent proven scientific record after the PhD. degree),
- 2. documented, by participation in projects, experience in science,
- 3. documented, by succesfull applications, practice in receiving financing for research;
- 4. documented teaching experience, including supercision and promotion of at least one PhD candidate
- 5. international experience (documented internship abroad, visible activity on an international scale).

#### In addition, we expect:

- 1. documented record of scientific publications and achievements valuable for one of the research groups at the Information Optics Department Institute of Geophysics,
- 2. research plans accounting for research group agenda.

#### Purpose and legal grounds of data processing

Personal data of candidates for employment shall be processed for recruitment purposes only.

Your personal data shall be processed in the scope as indicated by employment law<sup>1</sup> (given name (names) and family name, date of birth, contact information as provided, education, professional qualifications, previous employment) for the purposes of this recruitment process<sup>2</sup>, whereas other data<sup>3</sup> shall be processed based on your consent which may take the following wording:

If your documents include data as mentioned in Art. 9 section 1 of the GDPR (special categories of personal data), processing shall be possible upon your consent to processing such data<sup>4</sup> which may take the following wording:

The University of Warsaw shall be also processing your personal data in future recruitment processes upon your consent<sup>5</sup> which may take the following wording:

I consent to processing of my personal data for the purposes of any future recruitment processes at the University of Warsaw for the period of the next nine months.

You may revoke all such consents at any time by, for example, sending an email at <u>Sekretariat.IGF@fuw.edu.pl</u> (email address due for the recruitment process).

*Be advised that the revocation of your consent does not affect legal compliance of processing which had been completed upon consent before its revocation.*<sup>6</sup>

#### Data retention period

Your personal data collected in this recruitment process shall be stored over the period of three months from the date the recruitment process is completed.

In case you agree to process your data in future recruitments, your data shall be used over the period of nine months.

#### Data recipients

Officers authorized by the Controller shall have access to your personal data, the processing of which is in the scope of their duties.

Recipients of personal data may be other subjects obligated by the Controller to provide specific services involving data processing, like members of the competition committee.

#### Data transfer outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

Your personal data shall be disclosed to subjects authorized by law. Signing-in is through Google Forms.
