

Basic information about the organization of solid state physics seminar in remote mode.
(version 3.0)

The seminar in remote mode is carried out using the Zoom program.

On Friday at 10:00 (will work only after the session is opened by the coordinator) connect to the website:

Choose: "Join A Meeting"

Provide: Meeting ID: 721 883 8148

Most often, just click the link, then agree to install the program (the first time you use it), accept the connection of "computer audio", and (yes or no) connect your own camera.

Sometimes the camera has to be turned on "manually" (icon in the bottom left corner).

If clicking the link does not lead to success, look for the option:

"If you cannot download or run the application, join from your browser."

By clicking the link, we go to the login window, where you will need: Meeting ID

This option works best with the Chrome browser (even for XP, but with problems).

After joining the session, please turn off the microphone.

Using the "Chat" option in the menu, please send to me (not to everyone) your name in the body of the letter to create an attendance list. (Only name and surname - no additions. Other texts, in a separate letter).

During the seminar, you can turn on the microphone and ask the questions.

During the discussion you can use the "Raise Hand" option (bottom in the Participants window), but I may not notice it and then please just turn on the microphone and speak.

Warning!!:

I know signals about problems with the Zoom application. I recommend:

1) Install the latest version of the program from the site:

2) Avoid unnecessary chat.
